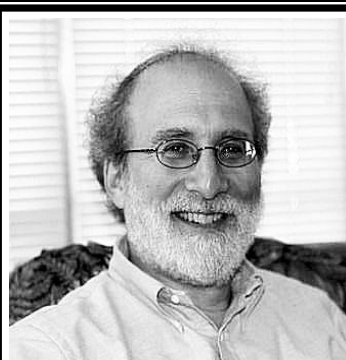

Robert Kraft's Foundation to Combat Antisemitism Super Bowl ad with a blue square covering hatred generated controversy. Complaints included: the Jewish student was passive and relied on others; gestures are not enough (it neither shows a perpetrator nor the slur's consequence); it's not universal enough, only when we broaden it to include all hate will we get non-Jews to realize that Jews feel antisemitism (93% of Jews think it's a problem vs 70% of non-Jews – 63% of those under 30 years old, yet only 51% can define antisemitism)/this country is great because all are equal citizens and so all are protected; it shows how wrong our institutions are – in Bret Stephens' comment a few days earlier, we must dismantle the ADL (and presumably Kraft's ad) and invest more in Jewish identity (Pennsylvania Gov. Josh Shapiro recently commented that after the antisemitic attack on his residence on Pesah, he deepened his faith); and more. They're all good points. Usually, life's

complexity needs more than one way to handle it.

This column appears nearly on Purim, the first case of anti-Judaism. It occurred to Diaspora Jews with pagan sounding names (Mordekhai sounds like the god Marduk and Esther the goddess Ishtar); Esther hides her identity (Esther can be seen to come from the Hebrew root word meaning “hide”; and, like many Diaspora Jews, she also has a Hebrew name, Hadasah). We all know the story, which operates on a human level with no mention of God, though maybe there’s a veiled reference.

The issue of antisemitism, which keeps changing slightly as times change, is complex. I don’t have an answer to this age-old question. I will close with a story and an observation, which flows from my being a rabbi.

The quick-witted, later prime minister under Queen Victoria, Jewish convert to Christianity, Benjamin Disraeli, in

1835 debated Irish Catholic leader and Member of Parliament Daniel O’Connell. O’Connell had demeaned Disraeli in various articles for, as his name showed, he was a Jew. He called him a reptile and contended that it was not a term of reproach, but that Disraeli was a shame to the Jewish race. He also said, “We cannot really take seriously what Disraeli says. After all, he is a descendant of Jews.” Disraeli said, “Yes, I am a Jew, and while the ancestors of the right honorable gentleman were brutal savages in an unknown land, mine were priests in the Temple of Solomon.”*

Of course by then Disraeli, who had changed the spelling of his name, was Christian.

I don’t know if Bret Stephens is correct on how to respond to antisemitism, but antisemitism doesn’t motivate people to be Jews. He’s certainly correct about how to be a Jew. Antisemites don’t care whether we observe or are ignorant, so we should

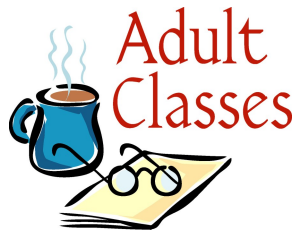

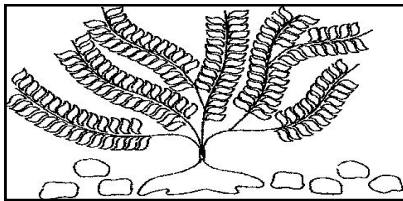
